

## II How to Use *N1 Grammar*

This chapter explains how to use *N1 Grammar* by focusing on those clickable objects, such as buttons and icons, that are pointed to by arrows. When you start “N1 Grammar” on your computer, the title page of *N1 Grammar* appears. Click on “CONTENTS” in order to go to the “CONTENTS” page, as shown in Figure 2-1.

Figure 2-1 Contents

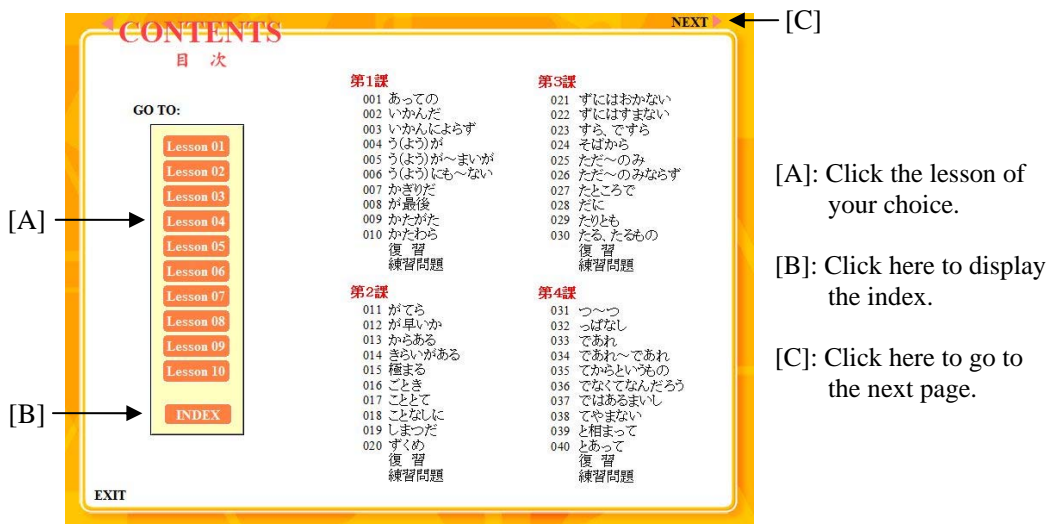


Figure 2-2 Lesson 4

[D]: Kanji Review (see Figure 2-7)

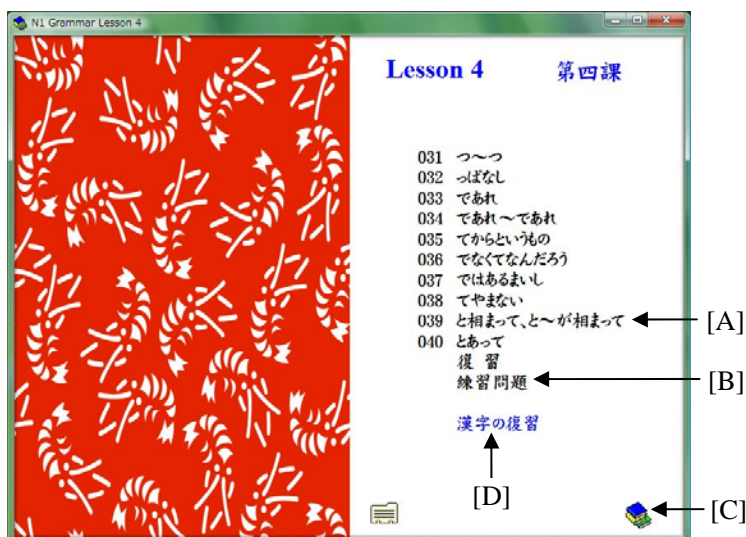
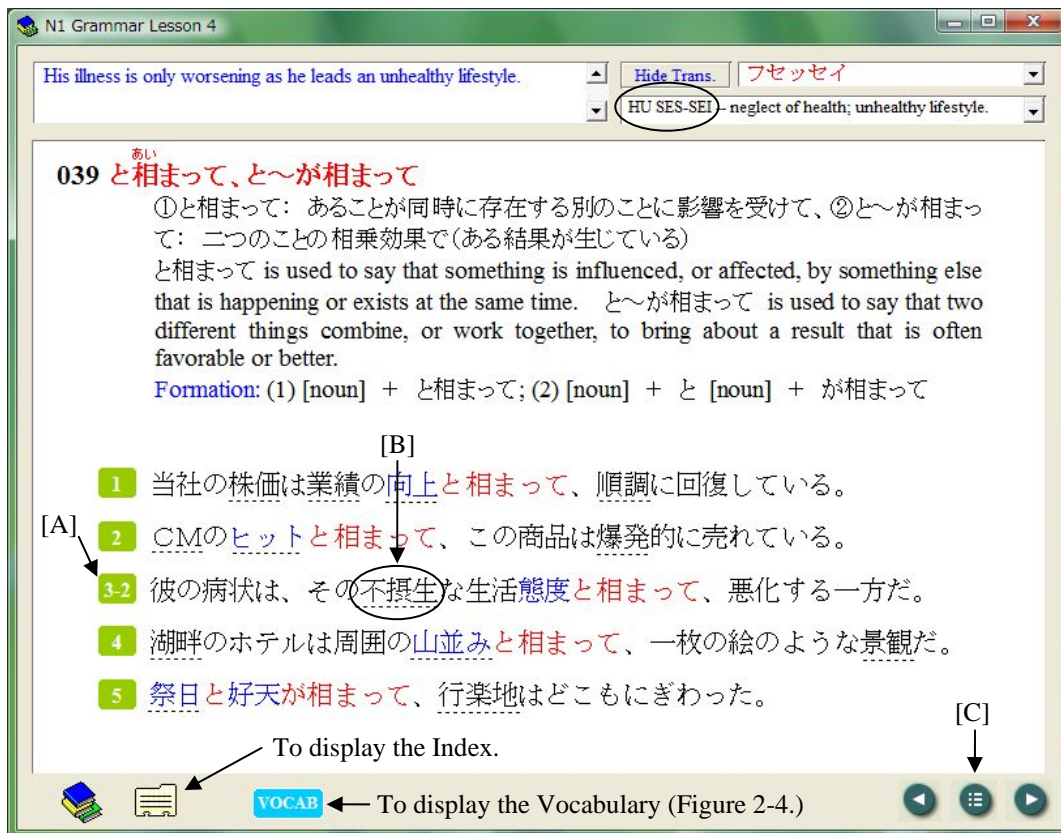


Figure 2-3 Entry #039

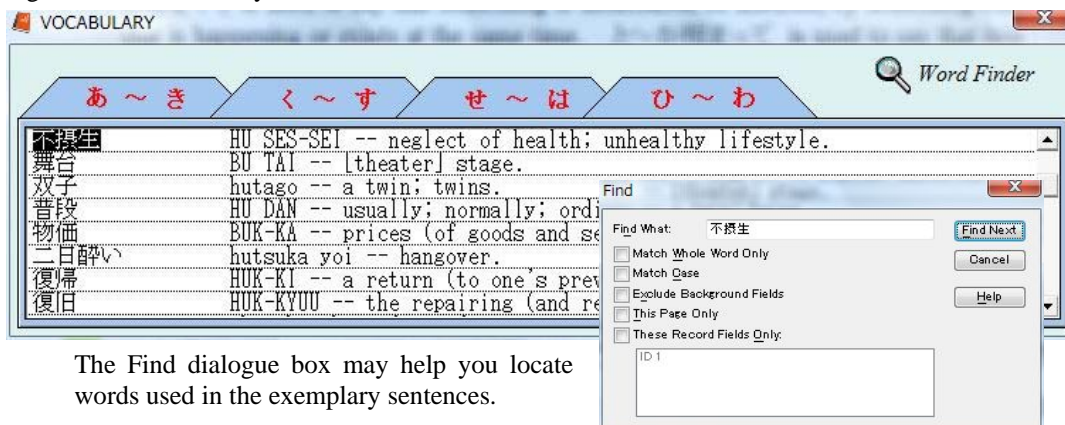


[A]: Click here to listen to the recording of each sentence and to see its English translation.

The Find dialogue box may help you locate words used in the exemplary sentences.

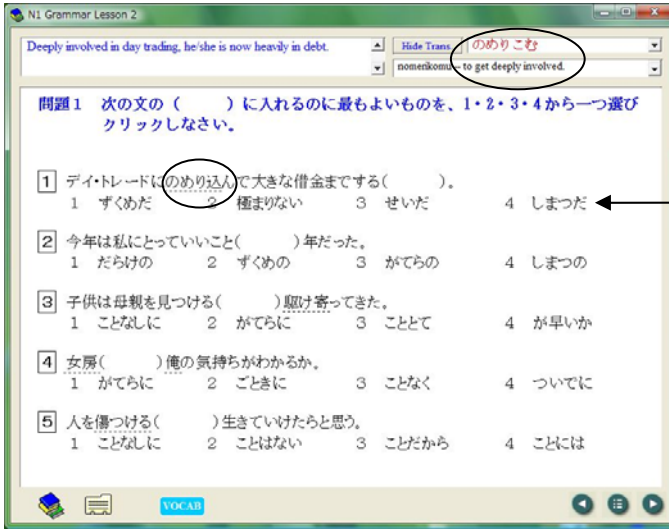
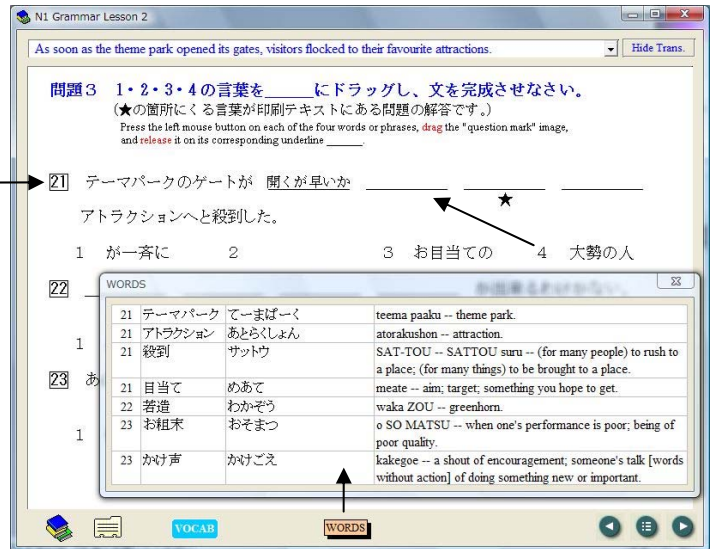


Figure 2-5 Exercises 1

Each exercise sentence will be read aloud only when you select a correct answer in a multiple-choice question.

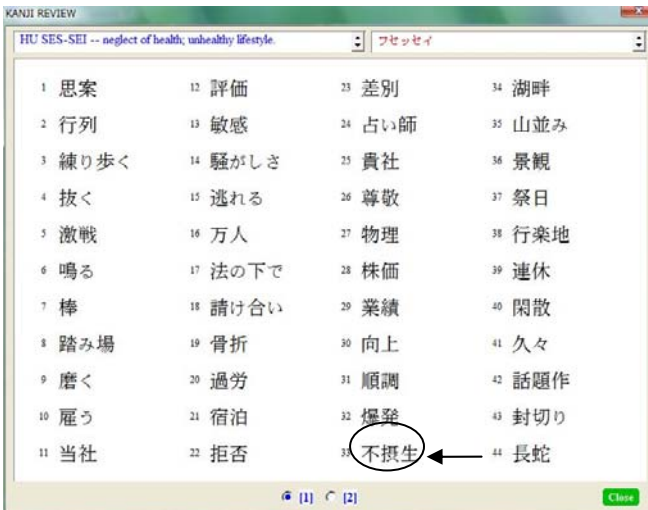
Figure 2-6 Exercises 3
