II How to Use N2 Grammar

This chapter explains how to use *N2 Grammar* by focusing on those clickable objects, such as buttons and icons, that are pointed to by arrows. When you start "N2 Grammar" on your computer, the title page of *N2 Grammar* appears. Click on "CONTENTS" in order to go to the "CONTENTS" page, as shown in Figure 2-1.







Figure 2-2 shows the list of grammar items in Lesson 1.

[A]: Click the grammar item of your choice.

[B]: To go to Exercises.

[C]: Click this icon to return to the Contents page (Figure 2-1).

[D] Kanji Review (see Figure 2-7).





[A]: Click here to listen to the recording of each sentence and to see its English translation.

[B]: Click on the word or phrase on the dotted line to listen to its recording and to display its phonetic transcriptions as well as its meanings.

[C]: The navigation buttons allow you to go to the next page, the previous page, or the first page in each lesson (Figure 2-2).
